The Importance of Relining your Denture

A denture reline is a simple procedure to reshape the underside of a denture, so that it fits more comfortably on your gums. Relining is periodically necessary as dentures lose their grip in the mouth due to bone loss or gum shrinkage. At the Burlington Denture Clinic, we recommend having your dentures relined every 2-3 years. Relining a denture will affect its fit and feel, it will not change the appearance or bite.

A denture reline is a one day process that is completed in our state of the art laboratory on site.





Replacing Dentures

Replacing your dentures is usually recommended every 5-7 years. When you have dentures, you should want them to work effectively and look natural in your mouth. We want you to look and feel attractive and able.

When inquiring about a new set of dentures, we can determine if your current denture materials have deteriorated at all or if you can use your dentures for more years to come. Sometimes, a patient's jaw may have shifted due to bone loss, so new dentures will need to be created and customized in order for them to fit properly again. Well-fitting dentures work best and look both attractive and natural.

If you are experiencing impaired chewing abilities, unattractive wear of your dentures, discomfort, or your dentures continue to fall out of place, speak with us to determine if it is time to replace your dentures.
